



A UNIFORM CODE

The best schools have a very strong sense of commonality and uniformity across aspects of their provision.

At Holy Trinity Primary School and Community Nursery it is our policy to ask you to send your children to school in the appropriate school uniform. A school uniform is important as it provides the school with a clear identity both in school and in the local community. It helps us to enable equality and a sense of justice in school. As a Church of England school this is very important to us and we need parents to support the school through the uniform regulations.

Our uniform is easy to source and very affordable.

Full details of the regulations can be found in this publication, the most recent version of which can always be found on our website.



SCHOOL COAT

The coat must be waterproof, easy to put on and do up, especially for our younger pupils. The children have playtime in light showers so need adequate protection. It must have a hook so that your child can easily place it on a hook in our cloakrooms.



BLACK SHOES

Lace up or velcro. Sturdy shoes or sandals (with a covered front and back) suitable for playtimes. Ballet pumps, crocs, 'vans' style shoes and heels are not suitable. Boots cannot be worn in class. Wellingtons are a sensible option in the winter but your child will need to change into shoes on arrival at school.



SCHOOL SWEATSHIRT OR CARDIGAN WITH SCHOOL LOGO

This is one of the few uniform items that must be purchased through the school. It is sensible to buy two to allow for washing.



BLACK OR GREY SCHOOL TROUSERS

Chinos and cargo trousers are not permitted.



GREY SKIRT

Suitable length required, about knee length.



GREY PINAFORE

Suitable length required.



GREY OR WHITE SOCKS

Coloured socks and trainer socks with shoes are not permitted. Dark coloured tights may be worn in the winter.

WHITE POLO SHIRT (PLAIN OR WITH SCHOOL LOGO)

Plain white polo shirt with no logos. This shirt cannot be

used for PE lessons, a T shirt is required for PE.

REGULATION SUMMER UNIFORM



GREY SHORTS

During the warmer weather black/grey shorts may be worn.



GREEN GINGHAM SUMMER DRESSES

During the warmer weather a summer dress may be worn.



BASEBALL STYLE SUN HAT

We encourage children to wear a sun hat at play times for protection from the sun!

REGULATION PE KIT

Regulation School Uniform



PLAIN WHITE T SHIRT

Plain crew neck T-shirt with no logos except Holy Trinity Logo.



NAVY BLUE/BLACK SHORTS

Shorts should not be knee length, with no logos. No bermuda style shorts.



BLACK PLIMSOLLS FOR INDOOR PE

Slip on or velcro.



TRAINER FOR OUTDOOR PE

Please ensure that your child always has trainers for PE days.

No luminous laces please.



BLACK TRACKSUIT FOR WINTER

School tracksuits can be purchased through the school. Providing children wear a black coloured tracksuit, these can be purchased from external providers.

LABELLING

It is very important that all items of clothing are clearly labelled with your child's full name. We can then return lost items to you. At the end of each term unclaimed items are recycled.

HAIRSTYLE REGULATION

- We do not permit extreme hairstyles.
- Mohicans, tramlines and other shaved areas of the head, no matter how small, are not permitted.
- Hair can be any length but long hair must be tied back, on both boys and girls.
- Children are allowed short or shaved hairstyles but need to have adequate protection from the sun, especially in the summer months.
- Hair must be held back with a plain, neutrally coloured hair band/bobble or hairclip only. No brightly coloured bands or excessive hair decoration.
- Extensions are not permitted.

JEWELLERY AND MAKE-UP REGULATION

- One pair of stud style earrings is permitted but must not be worn on swimming or PE days.
- A watch is permitted.
- Friendship bands and other bracelets are not permitted.
- Necklaces are not permitted.
- Make-up, including nail varnish, is not permitted.

SWIMMING KIT ALL KIT MUST BE CLEARLY NAMED



Boys

Swimming trunks (not shorts); towel; swimming hat; flip-flop type footwear or jelly shoes; a suitable named bag

Girls

One-piece swimming costume; towel; swimming hat; flip-flop type footwear or jelly shoes; a suitable named bag.

SCHOOL UNIFORM MUST BE WORN EVERYDAY. IF A CLUB IS BEING ATTENDED AFTER SCHOOL CHILDREN MUST CHANGE BEFORE THE CLUB BEGINS.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH UNIFORM REGULATIONS

All parents need to comply with the regulations. Where a parent fails to comply we reserve the right to send a child home until the uniform complies with our regulations. The presentation of your child in school is important and poor presentation is noted.
