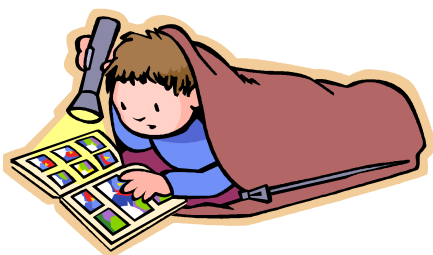
Would you be interested in supporting our children in learning to read?

You will need to have the following skills:

- ✓ Be a confident reader
- ✓ Be able to ask careful questions to check the children are understanding what they are reading
- ✓ Talk to children about books they enjoy
- ✓ Feedback to the teacher on the children reading
- ✓ Be prepared to attend an induction meeting in school
- ✓ Be prepared to access training in school – this will help you to support our children in school and also support your own children in the home



Listening to readers in school is a skilled job. At Holy Trinity School our aim is to ensure that all children are given the opportunities they need to become independent readers who love reading.
