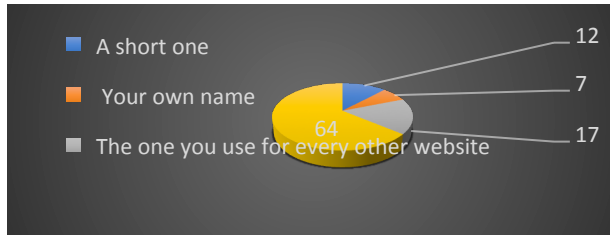


E-Safety

This is how children in Key Stage 2 answered:



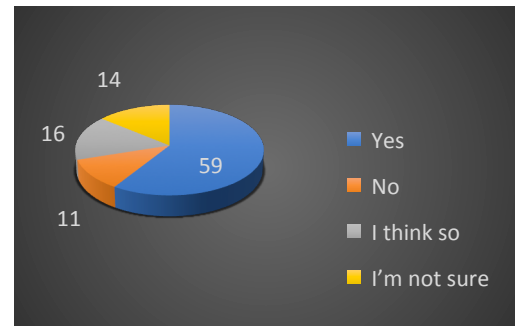
The correct answer is that you should use a password containing small and big letters, and numbers. This makes your password harder to guess if someone is trying to access your account.
